Rules of Procedure

1. The International Musicological Society (IMS) and the International Association of Music Libraries (IAML) are the sponsoring societies of the Répertoire International des Sources Musicales (RISM).
2. RISM is governed by the Governing Board (Vorstand) of the Verein Internationales Quellenlexikon der Musik e. V. (Verein), an association incorporated in Kassel, Germany and the Commission Mixte (CM).
3. The CM approves major policy decisions that affect the nature of RISM's activities and publications.
4. The CM consists of ten (10) members. They are proposed by IMS and IAML – five (5) by each society – and appointed by the Vorstand of the Verein, represented by its chair, in consultation with the Executive Boards of the sponsoring societies. By their appointment the members of the CM become members of the Verein.
5. The Vorstand of the Verein may appoint additional members of the Verein. According to the statutes of the Verein, its members elect the officers (Vorstand) for a term of three years. Candidates for chair, vice-chair, and officers at-large of the Vorstand are ordinarily drawn from the membership of the CM. The elected chair and vice-chair of the Vorstand serve concurrently as President and Vice President of the CM.
6. Members of the CM serve for a term of five years. They may be reappointed. Appointments made to replace a member not completing a term are for the original member's term.
7. The CM ordinarily meets once a year. It must gather once every three years for the Business Meeting of the Verein.
8. The CM considers reports from the Central Office (Zentralredaktion) of RISM and from other individuals and committees as appropriate.
